Draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Naval Air Station North Island San Diego, California



PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: February 16 - April 5, 2010

What is being proposed? The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on a draft Hazardous Waste Permit Renewal for the Hazardous Waste Facility Complex located at the Naval Air Station North Island (NASNI) in San Diego. If approved, the permit renewal would allow the facility to continue storing, treating, and recycling hazardous waste for another 10 years.

NASNI is an active military base which serves as the home port of several aircraft carriers and is part of the largest aerospace-industrial complex in the United States. As a result of the Facility's operations and services to other bases, hazardous wastes are generated and delivered by truck or pipeline to the Hazardous Waste Treatment Complex which houses five permitted storage units and two treatment systems.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT – NOTICE OF EXEMPTION – DTSC evaluated any possible environmental impacts associated with the proposed operations of this facility, as required by the California Environmental Quality Act. DTSC has prepared a Notice of Exemption which states that the hazardous waste facility would not have significant impacts to human health and the environment. The findings are available for public review in the information repositories listed below.
