

SUMMARY OF CHANGES ON FINAL PERMIT AND PERMIT APPLICATION

The following changes have been made on the final permit and the permit application based on the public comments received and internal reviews:

A Changes on the Final Permit

- Permit Number, Effective Date and Expiration Date were included on the cover page.
- The name "Naval Base San Diego" was added following references to the Naval Station San Diego since both names have been used by the Base. Therefore, changes were made on the cover page and other pages of the permit.
- Appendix B, Maximum Storage Plan was added to clarify the maximum storage in each bay. Therefore, changes were made on the cover page, Table of Contents page and page 8 of the permit.
- The two permit modifications dated May 17, 1994 and May 31, 1996 were added to the permit history on page 3 of the permit.
- The two application revisions dated March 8 and April 21, 2006 were added to the permit application document section on page 4 to reflect updated revisions to section X-A and section XIII of the permit application document.
- Unit Specific Condition was added on page 8 to clarify that compatible waste shall only be consolidated at the consolidation/repackaging area.
- Part VI – Compliance Schedule was added to set a deadline for the Federal Facility Site Remediation Agreement (FFSRA). Therefore, changes were made on the Table of Contents page and page 9 of the permit.

B Changes to the Permit Application

- The old section X-A of the permit application has been replaced with the updated section X-A which updates the Notification Procedures with the insertion of a phone number to contact the Residual Organization and updates Emergency Coordinator contact information.
- the old Section XIII of the permit application has been replaced with the updated Section XIII of the permit application that documents the corrective action progress and status of Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and Areas of Concern (AOCs)
