NOTICE OF FINAL PERMIT DECISION

under

California Code of Regulations

Issuance Date: June 22, 2006

In accordance with the requirements of California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.14 (22 CCR 66271.14), the California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this final decision to issue a Hazardous Waste Facility (HWF) Permit to:

NAVAL STATION SAN DIEGO
AKA NAVAL BASE SAN DIEGO
HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY, BUILDING 3458
SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA
EPA ID NUMBER CA6 170 024 289

The public comment period for the draft HWF Permit was from March 7, 2006 to April 21, 2006. A Public Hearing was conducted on April 6, 2006 at the National City Civic Center, City Council Chambers to receive public comments on the draft HWF Permit. DTSC received written comments concerning the proposed draft HWF Permit. A copy of the Response to Comments will be provided to all those who commented.

The Permit was signed on June 22, 2006. This action constitutes a final permit decision under Title 22, California Code of Regulations, section 66271.14(a) and the permit will become effective on July 27, 2006 unless the permit decision is appealed.

The final Permit may be appealed in accordance with the Title 22, California Code of Regulations, section 66271.18. Any person who filed comments on the draft Permit or who participated in the public hearing on the draft Permit may petition the DTSC to review any condition of the final Permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or failed to participate in the public hearing on the draft Permit may petition for administrative review only on the extent of the changes from the draft Permit to the final Permit.

The petition must include a statement of the reasons supporting the request for review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period, or were not reasonably ascertainable at the time of the public comment period. When appropriate, the petition must show that the condition in question is based on: 1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous; or 2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which DTSC should review.

A petition must be submitted to DTSC requesting a review of the permit decision within a 30 day appeal period beginning on June 27, 2006, and ending July 26, 2006. The Permit becomes effective on July 27, 2006, unless a petition for review is filed. The petition must be sent to:
