Dear Mr. Musselwhite:

This letter is to inform you that the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received your June 22, 2007, Revised Contingency Plan and your October 2005, revisions to the Hazardous Waste Operation Plan (Revised OP) for your hazardous waste storage facility (Building 1365) located at Travis Air Force Base in Solano County (facility).

You submitted a Hazardous Waste Facility Permit Renewal Operation Plan to DTSC on November 8, 2002. After review the application for technical completeness, DTSC sent you a Notice of Deficiency letter on July 15, 2005.

DTSC has carefully reviewed your Revised OP and the June 22, 2007 Revised Contingency Plan. DTSC concludes that the OP is now administratively and technically completed. This means that DTSC will initiate to prepare a hazardous waste facility permit (Permit). DTSC will also prepare a Statement of Findings for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The draft Permit, the CEQA Notice of Findings will be public noticed in the near future.
