Green Ribbon Science Panel

Subcommittee Teleconference Meeting

Subcommittee 3: De Minimis and

Unintentionally-Added Chemicals

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is convening a teleconference meeting of the Green Ribbon Science Panel (GRSP) **Subcommittee 3: De Minimis and Unintentionally-Added Chemicals**, on Wednesday, April 6, 2011 from 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon Pacific Time. The purpose of this teleconference meeting is for the GRSP subcommittee to discuss issues related to de minimis and unintentionally-added chemicals as part of DTSC's implementation of green chemistry law. This is one of two teleconference meetings of this subcommittee to explore the issues in depth, in preparation for a physical meeting of the entire Green Ribbon Science Panel that will be held in Sacramento, California, on May 5, 2011 and May 6, 2011.

The GRSP was established by AB 1879 (FEUER) (Chapter 559, Statutes of 2008) to provide the following advice and recommendations to the DTSC and the California Environmental Leadership Council:

- (a) Advise DTSC and the California Environmental Leadership Council on scientific and technical matters in support of the statutory goals of significantly reducing adverse health and environmental impacts of chemicals used in commerce, as well as the overall costs of those impacts to the state's society, by encouraging the redesign of consumer products, manufacturing processes, and approaches.
- (b) Assist DTSC in developing green chemistry and chemicals policy recommendations and implementation strategies and details, and ensure these recommendations are based on a strong scientific foundation.
- (c) Advise DTSC and make recommendations for chemicals the Panel views as priorities for which hazard traits and toxicological end-point data should be collected.

(d) Advise DTSC in the adoption of regulations required by article 14 (commencing with section 25251) of chapter 6.5 of division 20 of the Health and Safety Code.

(e) Advise DTSC on any other pertinent matter in implementing the statute, as determined by DTSC.

MEETING DETAILS

The meeting will be conducted via conference call on Wednesday, April 6, 2011, from 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon Pacific Time. GRSP subcommittee members will participate over the phone from the various designated and publicly-accessible locations listed below.

The public is invited to attend and may provide comments to the GRSP subcommittee. Members of the public will be placed on "listen-only" mode until the public comment portion of the meeting begins. At that time the conference operator will admit individuals for comments. Instructions for making comments to the GRSP subcommittee will be given at the beginning of the teleconference.
