Dangerous Chemicals Found in Yuba City

On Friday January 25th, the CA Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will announce that it has found hazardous (and potentially) explosive chemicals at a site in Yuba City.

DTSC will release details on how its Emergency Response Unit is making the premises and neighborhood safe and removing an imminent danger to the community.

Reporters/photographers wanting to cover this event should assemble at Garden Highway and Wilbur Avenue (near the Fellowship Center) in Yuba City. They will be taken to the site in question, for a press briefing and visual opportunity at 10am.
