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\$8,474 Settlement Reached with S & R Services, Incorporated

Los Angeles --- The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) today announced a \$8,474 settlement with S & R Services, Incorporated (S & R) for a hazardous waste violation at its facility located at 7614 Warner Avenue in Huntington Beach.

Under terms of the Consent Order (Order), signed in August 2004, S & R will pay a total of \$8,474, of which \$4,474 is an administrative penalty and \$4,000 is reimbursement of costs incurred by DTSC. The settlement stems from a violation observed during DTSC's February 18, 2004 inspection at the facility. S & R, a registered hazardous waste hauler, was cited for holding hazardous wastes longer than 10 days at its transfer facility without an authorization from DTSC.

S & R has since corrected the violation.

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The Department of Toxic Substances Control's mission is to restore, protect, and enhance the environment and ensure public health, environmental quality and economic vitality by regulating hazardous waste, conducting and overseeing cleanups, and developing and promoting pollution prevention.
