DTSC & CWA Sponsor Manifest Training in Redding

SACRAMENTO – The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is co-sponsoring manifest training with the California Waste Association (CWA). CWA is a non-profit statewide association of companies which generate, transport, treat, store and dispose of wastes (including recyclable materials and hazardous waste), as well as related service firms including engineers and consultants.

The free three-hour workshops are scheduled in July in Redding. The course includes a discussion of recently adopted federal regulations and manifest examples comparing use of current and new forms, how to avoid common manifest errors, and a question and answer period.

With this information, businesses will be prepared to comply with the new federal manifest requirements. **Please register early - each morning or afternoon session only accommodates 100 people.**
