Environmental Cleanup Project to Receive \$700,000 Loan From State

Murrieta - - The California Department of Toxic Substances Control Director Ed Lowry will present a check for \$700,000 to Steve Rosetta of Crossroad Investors III, LLC on March 26, 2002 at the Crossroads site located at 24250 Adams Avenue, Murrieta at 12:00 p.m. The check, issued by the Department's Cleanup Loans and Environmental Assistance to Neighborhoods (CLEAN) Program, for low interest loans will be used to excavate and remove lead contaminated soils from the 20-acre site. After the removal and cleanup the site will be used to construct new houses and provide open space.
