

# Stakeholder Questions for NPEs in Laundry Detergent Profile

## 1. Clarity of Scope

- a. Is the definition of the class of NPEs clear?
- b. Is the product definition clear and unambiguous as to which related products are included or excluded?

## 2. Demonstration of Significant or Widespread Adverse Impacts

- a. Is the information on adverse impacts sufficient and clear?
- b. Is the information on exposure sufficient and clear?

## 3. Information on Product Use

- a. Are there more information about the status of phase-out of NPEs in laundry detergents?
- b. Are there other products with significant amounts of NPEs that have a pathway to the aquatic environment?
- c. Are there engineering controls available to limit human or environmental exposure to NPEs or NPEDs?

## 4. Additional Considerations

- a. Is there additional information relating to Chemicals of Emerging Concern and California's drought?
- b. Are there additional studies evaluating the effects of NPEDs on benthic organisms?
- c. Is there additional information relating to NPEDs' ability to leach out of biosolids and enter the aquatic environment?
- d. Would adopting this proposal have other implications to water authorities or other governments?

## 5. Information on Alternatives

- a. What are the likely alternatives to replace NPEs in laundry detergents?
- b. How difficult would it be to conduct an Alternatives Analysis, given the extent of existing knowledge on chemical alternatives?
- c. Are there hazards and/or exposure concerns with currently available chemical alternatives in laundry detergents?
- d. Are there cost and/or performance concerns with currently available chemical alternatives in laundry detergents?
