#### **WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?**

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites public comment on the draft Removal Action Workplan for the Los Angeles Unified School District's Central Los Angeles Area New High School #1 Site. This workplan addresses the removal and off-site disposal of approximately 125 cubic yards of soil at the proposed site, which is bounded by Sunset Boulevard, Van Ness Avenue, Fountain Avenue and Wilton Place in Los Angeles. During the site investigation, arsenic was detected in an isolated area in shallow soils at concentrations that exceed health risk standards. Therefore, the contaminated soil will be removed and transported to a permitted offsite disposal facility. The impacted soil generally exists no deeper than 10 feet below ground surface.

#### **WHY THIS NOTICE?**

The purpose of this notice is to provide the interested public the opportunity to learn more about the project and provide comments to DTSC, concerning the proposed soil removal action, within thirty (30) days of this notice.

#### **HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?**

Your participation is encouraged. Comments concerning the draft Removal Action Workplan may be submitted in writing to Ms. Robbie Morris, Project Manager, at the Department of Toxic Substances Control at the address listed below, and must be postmarked by November 23, 2001.
