Draft Removal Action Work Plan Christopher High School Site (Former Silveira Property, Residential)



Public Comment Period: April 6, 2009 to May 8, 2009

The Department of Toxic Substance Control (DTSC) is accepting public comments on the Draft Removal Action Work Plan (RAW) for the future Christopher High School Site located at 850 Day Road, Gilroy, California. During an environmental investigation for the project, elevated levels of chlordane were found in a small section of the Site. The public comment period will run from **April 6, 2009 to May 8, 2009**. Written comments must be postmarked by the close of the public comment period and sent to:

The Draft RAW proposes the removal of 1,500 tons of contaminated soil from the 2.5-acre site as the recommended clean up alternative.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC has reviewed the proposed activities, and determined that they will not have any adverse effect on public health and the environment. Therefore, DTSC has exempted this project from CEQA requirements and has prepared a Notice of Exemption (NOE).
