COMPLETION OF FIVE-YEAR REVIEW American Canyon High School and Proposed Middle School Site American Canyon, California

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed the first Five-Year Review of the effectiveness of the cleanup remedy for American Canyon High School and the adjacent proposed middle school site (Site) located at 3000 Newell Drive, American Canyon, California 94503. The purpose of the Five-Year Review is to make sure the chosen remedy is still effective, functioning as designed, and maintained appropriately to protect human health and the environment.

The selected cleanup remedy was on-site containment of naturally occurring asbestos (NOA) as specified in the Removal Action Workplan in January 2009. The work was completed in July of 2009 and consisted of covering the Site with caps to minimize exposure to soil and rocks containing NOA. The caps consist of hardscape, soil caps, and landscaping. The remedy includes an Operations and Maintenance (O&M) agreement to ensure long-term monitoring of the Site. DTSC inspected the Site and reviewed project documents, including a report submitted by the Napa Valley Unified School District, yearly cap observation reports, and updated O&M plan.

On April 27, 2016, DTSC approved the Five-Year Review for this Site which concludes that the remedies continue to protect public health and the environment. The second Five-Year Review inspection is scheduled to be completed by August 31, 2020.
