### Completion of the Five - Year Review For BP LUBRICANTS USA (formerly Burmah Castrol, Inc)



**PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE:** The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed a Five - Year Review of the cleanup of contaminated soil at the Burmah Castrol Inc. Site (Site), located at 801 Wharf Street in Richmond, California. The Five -Year Review consists of a document review, technical evaluations, and Site inspections. The purpose of the Five -Year Review is to determine if the cleanup remedy implemented at the Site continues to be protective of human health and the environment. A Five -Year Review Report, which summarizes Site history, remedial actions, progress from the past Five -Year Review, technical assessments, recommendations and follow-up action, is generated after the review.

The Site has been used for industrial purposes since World War II, including shipbuilding and petrochemical storage and distribution. Since 1956, the facility has been used for bulk petroleum storage. Currently, the Site, paved parking, and tank areas cover approximately seven acres and include the Lube Oil Packaging area and Satellite Warehouse. Soils and groundwater were found to be contaminated with 1, 2-dichloroethane (1, 2-DCA), and groundwater and soil treatment were undertaken in 1986 and 1997 to address the contamination. A land use restriction was subsequently placed on the Site in 1991.

DTSC has determined that past onsite soil treatment and the land use restriction continue to: provide an effective barrier to contaminated soil, remain protective of human health and the environment, and effectively maintain low levels of 1, 2-DCA at the Site. Semi-annual groundwater monitoring results also suggests that the remaining concentration of 1, 2-DCA is not leaching into the soil. The next Five -Year Review is anticipated to occur in 2015, unless the Site's regulatory status changes.
