DRAFT REMOVAL ACTION WORKPLAN FOR BAYSHORE ELEMENTARY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

DALY CITY, CALIFORNIA

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: APRIL 28, 2016 — MAY 30, 2016

WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED? The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites your comments on the draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW) or cleanup plan at the Bayshore Elementary School District (District), Bayshore Elementary Reconstruction Project located at 155 Oriente St, Daly City, CA 94014 (Site). Environmental investigations at the Site indicate that near surface soils have been impacted with lead, organochlorine pesticides (OCPs), and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs). The draft RAW outlines plans to dig up and truck off soil having lead, OCPs and PCBs at concentrations exceeding levels that are protective of children's health and the environment.

If approved, approximately 1,500 in-place cubic yards (about 110 truckloads) of contaminated soil will be excavated and disposed of at an off-site permitted facility. Confirmation samples will be collected to ensure that contaminated soils have been removed to below cleanup goals established for residential land use. Soil excavation and off-site transportation of contaminated soil is expected to take four to six weeks to complete.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): DTSC is a Responsible Agency under CEQA. A Responsible Agency is defined in CEQA Guidelines (14 CCR § 15381) as a public agency which proposes to carry out or approve a project, for which the lead agency is preparing or has prepared an Environmental Impact Report or Negative Declaration. While DTSC is a Responsible Agency under CEQA for the overall construction project, DTSC will be the lead agency, which approves or determines the need to carry out a response action for which a mitigated negative declaration was adopted and will file a Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research (OPR) (PRC Section 21108 and Guidelines Section 15075(c)). A list of these notices shall be posted weekly by OPR and each list shall remain posted for at least 30 days (PRC Section 21108(c)).

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE? DTSC encourages you to take this opportunity to review and provide comments on the draft RAW. Comments on the draft RAW will be received from April 28, 2016 through May 30, 2016. All comments concerning the draft RAW must be received by the DTSC Project Manager Jose Luevano by May 30, 2016.
