BAYSHORE ELEMENTARY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT DALY CITY, CALIFORNIA

WORK BEGINNING: JUNE 13, 2016

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has approved the Removal Action Workplan (RAW) for Bayshore Elementary School District (District), Bayshore Elementary Reconstruction Project located at 155 Oriente St, Daly City, California 94014 (Site). Environmental investigations at the Site indicate that near surface soils have been impacted with lead, organochlorine pesticides (OCPs), and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs).

Details for the planned activities are provided below:

- The RAW will be implemented beginning on June 13, 2016, and is expected to be completed within 30-days of implementation. Fieldwork may be conducted intermittently depending on weather, results of confirmation sampling, landfill acceptance/availability and the need to proceed with over-excavation activities, and re-confirmation sampling of over-excavated areas until the cleanup level have been achieved;
- Dust and noise-generating work involving the use of any kind of electric, diesel fuel, or gasoline-powered machine or other power equipment will be limited to between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Construction activities will be prohibited on Sundays and federal holidays;
- Prior to the start of groundbreaking work, mobilization of equipment and removal of above ground features including shrubs may occur;
- Approximately 1,500 cubic yards of lead, PCB and OCP impacted soil will be excavated from the Site;
- Excavated soil will be temporarily stored in covered stockpiles on site before being transported by trucks to a licensed landfill for disposal. Soil may be left on site for a short period of time until approval from the landfill is received, but in no case shall it be left for over 90 days;
- Air monitoring and dust suppression activities will be completed during work to help prevent airborne dust contamination; and,
- Trucks will be inspected and truck beds will be covered prior to leaving the Site with excavated soil.
