



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
For Draft Removal Action Workplan  
Former Brentwood Rod & Gun Club Site**



The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces a 30-day public comment period on the Draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW) for the former Brentwood Rod & Gun Club Site (Site), located approximately 0.8 mile south of Balfour Road on the east side of Concord Avenue in Brentwood, California. DTSC will accept written comments on the Draft RAW. The Draft RAW describes in detail the investigation and recommendations to cleanup the contamination.

The Draft RAW recommends:

- Excavation of approximately 2,520 cubic yards of contaminated soil
- Consolidation of contaminated soil under clean fill
- Institutional controls ensuring that the property is not used for residential purposes

DTSC has determined that there are no negative environmental impacts resulting from this project, and therefore, to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), a Notice of Exemption (NOE) is proposed.

The 30-day public comment period begins February 21, 2006, and ends March 22, 2006.

All comments will be carefully considered before a final decision is made on the Draft RAW. All those who comment will be notified of the decision and will receive a copy of DTSC's Response to Comments document.
