### **Public Notice Community Advisory Group Recruitment Brisbane Baylands Brisbane, California April, 2005**

A Community Advisory Group (CAG) is being established with the assistance of the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC). This CAG is being developed pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code 25358.7.1 and in response to a petition signed by over 50 Brisbane community members. The Brisbane Baylands Project includes the Southern Pacific Brisbane Operable Unit 1, the Southern Pacific Brisbane Operable Unit 2, and the Brisbane Landfill sites in San Mateo County. These three properties are referred to as the Brisbane Baylands. The purpose of the CAG is to enhance public participation by involving the community in sites undergoing environmental cleanup.

CAG members will be asked to review and comment on technical documents relating to the environmental restoration and cleanup of the Brisbane Baylands. CAG members will be expected to serve as voluntary liaisons to the community and be available to share information about the clean up process with community members and/or groups. The CAG will include volunteer community members who reflect the diverse interests of the local community.

CAG meetings will be open to the public and community members are encouraged to attend meetings to learn more about the Brisbane Baylands project. If you are interested in applying for membership on the CAG, please contact:
