Soil Removal Planned – Starting June 28, 2007

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will oversee the removal of 2,958 cubic yards (4,437 tons) of soil containing lead-based paint from this property. Approximately 220 truckloads will be used to transport the soil.

To ensure public safety and minimize dust, following actions will be taken during this process:

- Temporary fencing with windscreens will be installed for security
- All vehicles will maintain slow speeds while on the property
- Spraying work areas with clean water to control dust
- Trucks will be secured with covers as they leave the site
- Truck tires will be brushed to remove soil and debris when entering and exiting the site
- Air monitoring at the site to ensure the amount of dust stays at safe levels

The work will be done between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. The work will take approximately 10 days to complete. Street closures are not anticipated.

Confirmation samples will be collected when the removal is completed to ensure that the cleanup goals are met.
