FIELD WORK BEGINNING DECEMBER 17, 2012

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this work notice to inform the community about DTSC approved work to collect soil and groundwater samples to verify the data for the feasibility study (FS). In addition, a faulty tide gate at outfall #2 in East Stege Marsh will be repaired.

WHAT WORK WILL BE DONE?

Soil samples will be collected from the Lot 3 Subarea at previous sample locations H-66 and Lot 3-37 where arsenic and benzo(a)pyrene were detected at concentrations greater than screening criteria. Multiple samples from step-out locations will also be collected and held at the laboratory for analysis subject to initial analytical results,

One ground water monitoring well will be constructed near the western part of Lot 3 where grab ground water sample results indicated elevated concentrations of carbon tetrachloride. Three monitoring wells will be constructed near grab ground water sample Lot 3-31 where elevated concentrations of trichloroethene (TCE) were detected.

The tide gate at outfall #2 will be repaired by installing a new valve inside the interceptor manhole. The old external valve will remain in place.

Work is expected to begin on December 17, 2012 (weather permitting) and continue through December 24, 2012. All work will be completed during normal business hours (8:00 AM to 5:00), Monday through Friday. Residents should expect to see:

- A drill rig and trucks
- Workers in protective gear
- Workers operating jack hammers and other hand tools
