## You may Review and Comment on the Cherryland Community Center Draft Removal Action Workplan

### Public Comment period: September 16 to October 16, 2016

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites public comment on a draft cleanup plan, or Removal Action Workplan (draft RAW), to cleanup lead and pesticide residue at the Cherryland Community Center Site, 278 Hampton Road and 17482 Boston Road, Hayward, California 94541. The property is currently vacant.

You can learn more about the proposed cleanup and provide comments to DTSC regarding the draft RAW during a 30 day public comment period that starts on September 16, 2016 and ends on October 16, 2016. Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC has prepared an Addendum to the Alameda County's 2015 Final Environmental Impact Report (Addendum) for this project. The Addendum states that the proposed cleanup will not have a significant negative effect on human health and the environment because of the short duration.
