



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC MEETING  
FOR PROPOSAL TO CLEAN UP CHEMICALS IN SOIL  
FORMER FULLERTON MANUFACTURED (MGP) GAS PLANT SITE  
FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA**

**WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED**

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites the public to review and comment on a proposed plan for cleaning up chemicals in soil. Soil contaminated with polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) is present at the former Fullerton Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) site and nearby Union Pacific Park. The 0.16 MGP site is located at 144 West Walnut Avenue, Fullerton. Union Pacific Park is located just south of the MGP site bordered south by Truslow Avenue. Businesses, residences and Union Pacific Park are located within one quarter mile of the MGP site. The proposed cleanup plan, called a draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW) consists of removing contaminated soil and backfilling clean soil in excavated areas.

**WHY THIS NOTICE AND HOW YOU CAN PARTICIPATE**
