This Work Notice is to inform the community of Fort Bragg that under the oversight of the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) Georgia-Pacific LLC (GP) will conduct cleanup activities at the former GP mill site beginning June 3, 2008. The cleanup activities are part of the Interim Action Remedial Action Plan (IA RAP), which addresses petroleum hydrocarbons in soil and groundwater. The work will be completed in two phases. The first phase of the cleanup will include the following activities:

- Existing building foundations will be removed so that contaminated soil can be accessed and excavated.
- The contaminated soil will be placed in a land treatment unit designed for treating soil.
- The contaminated soil will be treated for approximately 3 months by bioremediation (using microbes naturally occurring in the soil while adding nutrients and moisture) and then placed back into the excavations once it is clean.
- "Biosparging" of groundwater by adding nutrients and an oxygen-releasing material to it, and gentle aeration to encourage bioremediation of hydrocarbons.
- Use of dust suppression techniques and wind monitoring to minimize dust and debris. If wind activity becomes too strong, the work will be ceased until it is safe to continue.
- Materials that are not suitable to be re-used onsite will be taken to an approved landfill.
- Decontamination of any trucks leaving the Site, and covering truck beds if hauling material off-site is necessary.

These activities are the first phase of work and are expected to be completed in October 2008. The next phase will be implemented in April 2009 and is expected to be completed by October 2009.
