

# Public Notice

The mission of DTSC is to protect California's people and environment from harmful effects of toxic substances through the restoration of contaminated resources, enforcement, regulation and pollution prevention.

## General Dynamics NASSCO Building 6 Sump, 2798 Harbor Drive, San Diego, CA 92113

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites the public to review and comment on a proposed cleanup plan for the Building 6 Sump at the General Dynamics NASSCO facility. The proposed cleanup plan, called a draft Corrective Measures Proposal (CMP), describes the site environmental sampling activities, the results, and the cleanup activities proposed for the site.

### What Is Being Proposed?

- Approximately 60 cubic yards of soil will be excavated from the area around Building 6.
- Excavated soil will be transported to a permitted disposal facility using a properly licensed transporter.
- The excavation pits will be backfilled using clean soil and then re-paved.
- Monitored Natural Attenuation (MNA) of the groundwater will continue to be performed for two years after the excavation is complete.
- During the same two-year post-excavation period, sub-slab and soil vapor monitoring will also be performed, with the results used to determine risk level.
- If the monitoring indicates that the groundwater is not creating a risk at the surface and the site meets cleanup goals, then the site will be closed.
- If the monitoring indicates that the groundwater is creating a risk at the surface, or if cleanup goals are not met, additional groundwater alternatives will be evaluated.

### How You Can Participate

This notice provides the public an opportunity to learn more about the site and submit public comments on the draft CMP. **The 30-day public comment period begins on August 20, 2015, and ends on September 21, 2015.** Public comments must be postmarked or e-mailed no later than September 21, 2015, and sent to: Johnson Abraham, DTSC Project Manager. The draft CMP, draft California Environmental Quality Act Notice of Exemption, and other site related documents are available for public review at:
