WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED?

The California State Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites public comment on the draft Remedial Action Plan (RAP) for the Golden Technology Site at 3017, 3019 and 3033 Santa Rosa Avenue in Santa Rosa, California. A public meeting on this project will be held November 20, 2008 at Finley Community Center - Room Cypress A, 2060 W. College Avenue, Santa Rosa, California, from 6:00 to 8:30 p.m.

During previous environmental investigations, trichloroethylene (TCE) and cis-1,2-dichloroethene (DCE) were detected in groundwater above drinking water standards. Therefore, the draft RAP proposes to inject a carbon source called HRC[®] into shallow groundwater to stimulate microbial growth and conditions favorable to the in-place breakdown and destruction of the volatile organic compounds (VOCs), TCE and DCE. Monitoring wells would be installed and groundwater tested periodically to monitor progress towards cleaning up the contamination.

There is no immediate health risk because the impacted groundwater is not used for drinking water at the Site. Offsite properties within the defined groundwater plume either treat the groundwater prior to use if levels are above drinking water standards or do not use groundwater for drinking water.

DTSC has prepared a draft Notice of Exemption (NOE) for this cleanup activity pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This project is considered exempt since it will not have a significant negative impact on the human health.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

This notice provides the community an opportunity to learn more about the project and provide comments to DTSC about the proposed cleanup during the public comment period. Your participation is encouraged.
