## THE GROUPS 1A AND 10 RCRA FACILITY INVESTIGATION REPORTS SANTA SUSANA FIELD LABORATORY SIMI HILLS, VENTURA COUNTY



**Public Comment Period: June 30, 2009 – August 30, 2009**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to review and comment on the Groups 1A and 10 Resource Conservation Recovery Act Facility Investigation (Groups 1A and 10 RFI) Reports. The Group 1A RFI Report presents the results of the chemical contamination investigation done in 9 areas, including B-1 Area (B-1), Instrument and Equipment Laboratories (IEL), Area I Landfill (AILF), Building 1359 (B359), Happy Valley North (HVN), Happy Valley South (HVS), Advanced Propulsion Test Facility (APTF), Laser Engineering Test Facility (LETf)/Component Test Laboratory I (CTL-I), and Canyon Area (Canyon). These areas are located in the northeast portion of Area I at the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL). The Area 1 Burn Pit is not included in this RFI Report. The Group 10 RFI Report presents the results of the chemical investigation done in the southern undeveloped area of SSFL. The RFI Reports were submitted to DTSC by The Boeing Company (Boeing) as required by a DTSC consent order. Prior to completing our review and providing comments to Boeing, DTSC is inviting public comment. DTSC welcomes your comments and will consider them before preparing comments to Boeing. These Reports provide a basis for evaluation of future cleanup activities.
