## Former Hard Chrome Engineering

**Field Work Beginning September 27, 2010**

### Purpose of this Work Notice:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about upcoming work at the former Hard Chrome Engineering Site (Site) located at 750 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Oakland, California. Previous investigations have shown the presence of hexavalent chromium and tetrachloroethene (PCE) in the groundwater beneath the Site. Additional groundwater investigation is needed to determine the extent of contamination. Currently, the groundwater is not a source of drinking water in the area.

### What happens now?

Beginning **September 27, 2010**, three groundwater monitoring wells will be installed. Groundwater samples will be collected from these new wells and from previously installed monitoring wells. All work will be conducted Monday- Friday between the hours of 7:30 AM and 5:30 PM. Work will finish in approximately two weeks. During this time, you can expect the following:

- Drilling equipment and staff to install the three wells
- The use of portable pump equipment to extract a sample of water from each well
- No significant disruption of traffic, dust, or other nuisances are associated with this work

The work will be done according to the Groundwater Investigation Workplan reviewed, and approved by DTSC on August 24, 2010.
