



**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**Approval of Final Remedial Action Plan**  
**For Former Kaiser Aerotech Facility**  
**San Leandro, California**



The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has approved the cleanup plan for the former Kaiser Aerotech Facility (Kaiser Facility) located at 880 Doolittle Drive and 498 Hester Street, San Leandro. Investigations at the Kaiser Facility have found that soil, soil vapor, and shallow groundwater beneath the site are contaminated with volatile organic compounds (VOCs). The primary contaminants of concern are trichloroethene (TCE), and its break down products; cis-1,2-dichloroethene (cis-1,2-DCE), trans-1,2-DCE, 1,1-DCE and vinyl chloride. The Kaiser Facility was used to manufacture aerospace and aircraft equipment. TCE was used mainly as a solvent to remove grease from metal parts. The groundwater beneath the Kaiser Facility is not used as a drinking water source.

The approved cleanup plan will address the contaminated groundwater under the Kaiser Facility by using a treatment called enhanced reductive dechlorination (ERD). This treatment involves injecting a food-grade substance, such as sodium lactate, into the contaminated groundwater to help accelerate the natural process of breaking down the contaminants. Monitored natural attenuation (MNA) will be used in the lower concentration areas. MNA relies on the natural physical, chemical, and biological processes to break down the contamination in the groundwater. The cleanup plan, called a Final Remedial Action Plan (RAP), describes in detail the investigations and approved cleanup activities for the Kaiser Facility. DTSC invites you to review the approved Final RAP. The Final RAP is available for your review on-line and at the Information Repositories listed below.
