NOTICE OF FIVE-YEAR REVIEW Alden and Chapel Parks, Investigation Area D1.2 Former Mare Island Naval Shipyard, Vallejo

The City of Vallejo and the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) are starting the second five-year review for Alden and Chapel Parks located in Investigation Area D1.2 (IA D1.2), Former Mare Island Naval Shipyard, Vallejo, California, 94592. The draft Five-Year Review Report will be submitted to DTSC in October 2016 and completed in November 2016.

What is a Five-Year Review?

The purpose of the review is to make sure the chosen remedy is still effective, functioning as designed, and maintained appropriately to protect human health and the environment. DTSC also conducts a search to determine if any new regulatory requirements have been established since the cleanup decision. This entire process is repeated every five years.

Why is a Five-Year Review being done for this site?

DTSC approved the use of a Land Use Covenant (LUC) as part of the remedy for a portion of IA D1.2, including Alden and Chapel Parks, following completion of environmental remediation in April 2006. The LUC is in place in the non-residential areas of IA D1.2 in order to ensure appropriate land use and protect human health and the environment from the remaining contaminants in soil as a result of historic U.S. Navy activities.

In 2010, the City of Vallejo acquired both Alden and Chapel Parks. These two properties will be assessed during this five-year review. The five-year review process will evaluate the continued effectiveness of the LUC to protect human health and the environment as intended.
