## INSTALLATION RESTORATION SITE 3 REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN

### CEQA NEGATIVE DECLARATION

### Naval Base San Diego

#### Former Salvage Yard

#### San Diego County, California

**30-Day Public Comment Period: January 7, 2011 - February 7, 2011**

**WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?** Under the California Health and Safety Code, section 25356.1, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) proposes to approve a Remedial Action Plan (RAP) to excavate and dispose off-site, contaminated soil within Installation Restoration (IRP) Site 3 (Project) to eliminate the potential inhalation, dermal contact, and ingestion pathways to current workers and potential ecological receptors.

This RAP consists of the Navy's Proposed Plan (PP) for the final remedial action to address soil impacted with arsenic, dioxins, dibenzofurans, and organic lead at Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 3, the Former Salvage Yard, at Naval Base San Diego (NBSD). This proposed action will consist of the excavation and off site disposal of approximately 2,900 cubic yards of soil and asphalt.

Excavated material will be stockpiled on-site and disposed of at a permitted landfill facility, with treatment prior to disposal if necessary. The excavated areas will be backfilled with clean, imported soil, and the areas repaved. The proposed excavation areas in combination total approximately 0.19 acre.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA):** DTSC prepared an Initial Study for this Project. Based on evidence provided in the Initial Study, DTSC has determined that the proposed Project will not have any significant effect on the environment and that there is no need to adopt any mitigating measures.
