## Draft Removal Action Workplan Available for Navistar International in Richmond, CA Public Comment Period: May 6 to June 6, 2016

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites public comment on a draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW) for Navistar International Transportation (Site) located at 830 Marina Way South, Richmond, California 94804. The draft RAW describes the investigations and proposed cleanup activities for the Site.

In 1947, International Harvester began using the Site for storage and distribution of parts for heavy trucks, industrial power equipment, agricultural tractors and equipment, and refrigeration equipment. In 1986 International Harvester became Navistar International and continued using the Site. In 2006 Navistar International left the property. Future plans for the Site include a residential/commercial development. High levels of lead and arsenic were found in soils in several areas. High levels of total petroleum hydrocarbon (TPH) and benzene were found in specific areas.

The draft RAW proposes excavating and transporting contaminated soil to a permitted disposal facility. Clean fill would be brought into the Site. Passive vapor mitigation would control entry of VOCs into buildings. This option is most protective of human health and the environment and will clean up the property for future residential use.
