## Work Notice, May 2009

# School District begins work at Oakridge High School on June 1, 2009

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will continue to oversee field work to minimize the potential release of asbestos from soil at the Oak Ridge High School located at 1120 Harvard Way in El Dorado Hills. The actions, starting on June 1, are a continuation of the Removal Action Workplan, approved by DTSC on April 11, 2008, for the improvements at Oak Ridge High School. DTSC will oversee work in Area A to remove portable classrooms and pave the area with asphalt and in Area E, the conversion of the football field from grass to synthetic turf. Please see the map (on the opposite side) for the locations of areas A and E. This field work includes the following efforts to minimize dust and maintain safety:

- **Temporary fencing with windscreens will be installed for security**
- **All vehicles will maintain slow speeds while on the High School grounds**
- **Light water spray on all work areas to prevent dust**
- **Trucks secured with covers if they leave the High School with soil**
- **All truck tires washed to remove soil and debris when entering and exiting work areas**
- **Air sampling and dust monitoring in all work areas to make sure that dust and asbestos are below levels of concern.**

Work hours are 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM for approximately 6 weeks.

Trucks entering the Oak Ridge High School site will take El Dorado Hills Boulevard, turn right on Harvard Way and turn into the site. Trucks exiting the property will follow the same route in reverse.


