**Proposed Draft Remedial Action Plan For  
The PG&E Hunters Point Power Plant  
Is Available For Review  
San Francisco, California**

**Public Comment Period: February 5, 2010 to March 8, 2010**

**WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces a 30-day public comment period for the PG&E Hunters Point Power Plant site (Site) Draft Remedial Action Plan (RAP) and Public Meeting. The Site is located at 1000 Evans Avenue in San Francisco, California. The Draft RAP addresses site investigation activities, remedial action objectives, alternative remedial actions, and the recommended cleanup action for the Site. DTSC is accepting verbal and written public comments on the Draft RAP.

The recommended remedial action detailed in the Draft RAP includes:

- Removing soil contaminated by power plant operations, disposing of it at an appropriate offsite disposal facility, and backfilling the excavations.
- Paving the areas containing historic fill material once the excavations are complete. This fill material was derived from local serpentine rock which contains naturally-occurring asbestos (NOA) and metals (nickel, chromium, and cobalt).
- Treating the liquid petroleum floating on the surface of the groundwater underlying parts of the site in-place by injecting a chemical substance into the groundwater zone to break down the petroleum.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT - NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

Based on an Initial Study, DTSC has determined that no significant environmental impacts would result from the cleanup project, and therefore, in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), a Negative Declaration is proposed. The Negative Declaration and Initial Study are available for public review at the Information Repositories listed below.

**WHY THIS NOTICE?**

The purpose of this notice is to provide you with the opportunity to learn more about the project and to encourage you to provide DTSC with your comments on the Draft RAP and the proposed Negative Declaration. In addition, DTSC invites you to attend the Public Meeting scheduled on February 23, 2010.

**HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?**

By providing your comments on the Draft RAP and attending the Public Meeting scheduled for **February 23, 2010**. This meeting will begin at **6:00 PM** and will be held at **Our Lady of Lourdes Church, 410 Hawes Street, San Francisco, California 94124**. Comments may be submitted verbally or in writing at the Public Meeting and anytime during the public comment period. All comments will be carefully considered before a final decision is made on the Draft RAP. Notification of the final decision and a copy of DTSC's response to comments are provided to those who submit comments.
