Work Begins March 17, 2016

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about upcoming work at the Former Platinum Cleaners (Site) at 2290 West El Camino Real in Mountain View, CA 94040. This work is part of the Remedial Action Workplan approved on March 2, 2016.

The work will include installing a soil vapor extraction (SVE) system at the Site to clean up tetrachloroethylene (PCE) beneath a portion of the Site and at the adjacent Best Western parking lot. PCE is a chemical that has been commonly used in dry cleaning. The SVE system will be operated under a permit from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District.

What Work Will Be Done?

Work will occur from **March 17, 2016 through April 15, 2016 on weekdays between 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM.** These activities will not pose a threat to human health or the environment. During this time, you may see the following:

- A utility survey will be conducted to confirm the location of any utility lines.
- A drill rig will be used to drill borings to install multiple vapor extraction and monitoring wells at the Site and Best Western parking lot. This may cause brief periods of noise and vibration.
- Soil vapor samples will be collected from monitoring wells and tested for PCE and other volatile organic compounds.
- The SVE system will be installed inside the vacant building. Pipes will connect the vapor extraction wells to the SVE system. Fencing will be installed around the extraction wells.
- The air released to the atmosphere following treatment will be tested to make sure it is safe for human health and the environment.
