



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR  
Port of Oakland, Berths 25 & 26  
2500 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Oakland, CA**

**March 12, 2007 to April 11, 2007**



The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces a 30-day public comment period on a Draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW) and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Notice of Exemption for the Port of Oakland's Berths 25 and 26 Site, 2500 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Oakland, California. The Site has been an active marine container terminal since 1974.

This Draft RAW proposes to address groundwater contaminated with volatile organic compounds by passive product recovery, which is soaking up the contaminants with absorbent material, groundwater monitoring, maintaining the asphalt cap and a deed restriction for activities on the Site. DTSC has prepared a CEQA Notice of Exemption which states the activities involved in the cleanup of the Site will not have a significant impact on the environment. Therefore, the project is exempt from CEQA.
