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RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY ACT (RCRA) FACILITY
INVESTIGATION (RFI) REPORTING APPROACH MEETING, NOVEMBER 30, 2005,
SANTA SUSANA FIELD LABORATORY, VENTURA COUNTY,

Dear Mr. Lenox:

This is a follow-up to our meeting of November 30, 2005, in which we discussed the reporting approach for the RCRA RFI Surficial Media Operating Units (SMOUs). During this meeting, you indicated Boeing will be submitting 9 "bundled" area reports for the Department of Toxic Substances Control's (DTSC) review and approval over a 24- to 30-month period. The goal of the SMOU RFI Reports is to provide sufficient data to allow completion of the risk assessment and recommendations for the Corrective Measures Study (CMS) for the Surficial Media.

Boeing's goal (as outlined in Boeing's "SSFL Site Closure Expectations" paper dated January 19, 2005 and further discussed in a meeting with Boeing last February) is to complete characterization activities for surficial and deep groundwater media by 2008; cleanup contaminated soils, where applicable, by the end of 2010; initiate removal of soil vapor by early 2010; and initiate long-term groundwater cleanup by early 2010.

Please provide a schedule for submittal of the nine bundled RFI Reports to DTSC by January 16, 2006. The schedule should include an explanation of the rationale for selection of the bundled areas and submittals that is protective of public health and the

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environment. Once we receive the schedule and rationale, DTSC will meet with your staff and other interested agencies to discuss this further in light of the goals mentioned above.
