**Sherwin-Williams Site - 1450 Sherwin Street**

**Update on Site Status and Activities**

Sherwin-Williams completed the remedial action waste hauling from the former paint plant site located at 1450 Sherwin Street in Emeryville on Friday, March 30.

There are a few off-site activities still to be completed, associated with the City of Emeryville's requirements and CEQA mitigation measures. These include: 1) asphalt repairs along Halleck Street, between Park and Sherwin, 2) brick inlay repairs at the Halleck/Park intersection, and 3) hydro-seeding of the City owned land at the western end of Sherwin Street ("Parcel D").

All work will be scheduled to take place between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays only. The asphalt repairs on Halleck Street are scheduled for Thursday, April 5, but could be postponed to Friday, April 6, depending on weather conditions. The asphalt repairs will not affect parking on Halleck Street. Diesel equipment will be used, and the repairs should be completed within one work day. At least one lane will remain open to traffic at all times, and a flagger will be present to facilitate traffic movement.

Sherwin-Williams is working to identify a contractor qualified to perform the brick inlay work, and the hydro-seeding cannot start until the water that has ponded on Parcel D recedes. Additional notification will be provided to affected neighbors when these activities are scheduled.

The remaining activities to be completed on the Sherwin-Williams site include: cleaning the paved surfaces within the fenced area of the site, off-hauling the water that was collected from site dewatering activities (after recent rain events), and backfilling the remaining excavation area with clean soil that are already present on site. Sherwin-Williams plans to complete these on-site tasks by the end of this week, April 6.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control oversees all of this work.
