Water Service Expansion work being conducted beginning the week of July 21, 2008

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about upcoming work to be performed as a part of the installation of California Water Service (Cal Water) in the vicinity of the former Combustion Engineering, Inc. (CE) facility located at 37 Speedway Avenue in Chico, California. Groundwater in the vicinity of the former CE facility has been impacted by a release of trichloroethene (TCE) which is known as the Skyway Subdivision Groundwater Plume. Cal Water service will be made available to properties on Skyway Avenue, Hegan Lane, Bruce Lane and Cessna Avenue located downgradient of the former CE facility.


The site is shown on the map on the reverse side of this work notice. West Valley Construction is under contract to ABB Inc. to install the water lines near the former CE facility.

Work will begin the week of July 21, 2008 and construction activities will take place between the months of July and November 2008. Work hours will be between the hours of **7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday**. Work activities you may see include the following:

- Pre-field services (working with residents during survey activities.)
- Mobilization and demobilization of project equipment (storage area, set up for materials, etc.).
- Traffic control (shoring trenches, steel plate covers, direction signs for traffic, fencing, etc.). Traffic patterns will not be significantly affected.
- Digging trenches along Hegan Lane, Cessna Avenue, Skyway Avenue, and Bruce Lane to install a new water main, services and fire hydrants.
- Compaction testing for paving purposes.
- Gravel and asphalt paving over trenches for mains and service lines.
- The installation of the water line beneath the Union Pacific Railroad line that crosses Hegan Lane.
- In most cases minor restoration will be needed where service lines are installed on private property. West Valley Construction will be filming the entire project before work begins and all properties (lawns, shrubs, etc.) will be restored.

All work will be conducted in accordance with Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requirements. Workers may wear safety gear while working on-site and operating heavy equipment.
