Taylor Yard Parcel G2 –Southern Pacific Site Proposed Cleanup Plan, Los Angeles, California

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: October 10, 2013 through November 12, 2013

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED - The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites the public to review and comment on a proposed plan to clean up contaminated soil on the Taylor Yard Parcel G2 – Southern Pacific Site (Site). The Site is located at 2800 Kerr Street in Los Angeles, California. The cleanup plan, called a draft Remedial Action Plan (RAP), describes in detail the environmental samplings that have been conducted, the results, and the activities that are proposed to clean up the contaminated soil.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT – NOTICE OF EXEMPTION – DTSC evaluated any possible environmental impacts associated with the proposed closure of this facility, as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). DTSC has prepared an Initial Study – Negative Declaration (ND) for the Site. The ND states that the proposed cleanup will not have a significant negative effect on human health and the environment. The findings are available for public review in the information repositories listed below. The 30-day public comment period is from **October 10, 2013 to November 12, 2013**.
