REMOVAL ACTION at FORMER TITECT FOUNDRY 4000 West Valley Boulevard Pomona, California



Cleanup activities for soil contaminated with solvents, metals, and petroleum hydrocarbons are planned to start on September 1, 2005 at the former TiTech foundry site in Pomona. These cleanup activities may take approximately 30 to 60 days to complete. Our agency, the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), is overseeing the investigation and remediation of this property. The cleanup proposal, called a Removal Action Workplan (RAW), was approved by DTSC on January 3, 2004.

The foundry was constructed on vacant land in 1969 and operated until June 2002. Numerous site investigations by consultants found tetrachloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), and metals (arsenic, titanium and nickel) in soils at levels that could pose a health risk. The RAW proposes to clean up the site by removing the contaminated soils to an offsite disposal facility and using a soil vapor extraction system. If residential cleanup levels cannot be achieved, a deed restriction will be placed on the property to ensure that the property is restricted to industrial use only.
