NOTICE OF DECISION FOR CORRECTIVE ACTION FINAL REMEDY SELECTION

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is issuing this Notice of Decision for Corrective Action Final Remedy Selection (“Notice”) and approves the remedies for soil and groundwater set forth in the Final Draft Corrective Measures Study and Implementation Plan, dated June 14, 2006 for the Tyco Electronics Corporation (Tyco or “Facility”) at 300 Constitution Drive, Menlo Park, San Mateo County, California.

In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66271.9 regarding public notices, DTSC held a 45-day public comment period from July 27, 2006 to September 11, 2006 to seek public comments on the proposed remedies for the Facility, the Draft Negative Declaration, and Initial Study. DTSC prepared both the Initial Study and Draft Negative Declaration for this remediation project in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”). Both documents reflect the independent judgment and analysis of DTSC.

A public notice regarding the public comment period was published in the newspapers of the Palo Alto Weekly and Country Almanac, and was mailed to the persons and organizations on the facility mailing list. A DTSC Fact Sheet regarding the proposed remedies was included with the mailing of the public notice. Two public comment letters were received by DTSC during the public comment period. Comments were on both proposed remedies and Initial Study.

DTSC has prepared a Response to Comments document which has been made a part of the administrative record and is available to the public at the repositories listed at the end of this Notice. A copy of the Response to Comments will be mailed to those who submitted comments or otherwise requested. DTSC has therefore approved the proposed remedies and the Draft Negative Declaration with one minor change that Tyco shall install five new groundwater monitoring wells and abandon one well, in accordance with all appropriate local and state standards including but not limited to the County of San Mateo, the California State Department of Water Resources, and the Regional Water Quality Control Board standards. DTSC will be filing a Notice of Determination with the State Clearinghouse within five business days of project approval as required by CEQA and implementing guidelines.
