DTSC Approves first 5-Year Review of two Remedies for Active Rail lines, Union Pacific Curtis Park Site, 3675 Western Pacific Avenue, Sacramento CA 95818

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) completed a Five-Year Review (Review) for remedies at both the active rail corridor as well as the Sacramento Regional Transit District's light rail line through the former Union Pacific Curtis Park Site, 3675 Western Pacific Avenue, Sacramento CA 95818.

The purpose of these Reviews was to verify that the approved and implemented remedies continue to be protective of human health and the environment. The remedies require a land use covenant because lead, arsenic and other metals remain in the soil above levels that allow for unrestricted land use. The Review of both rail corridors evaluated the land use covenant and the soil management.

The Reviews included site inspections, document reviews, and technical evaluations. The Reviews concluded that the remedies are still protective of human health and the environment. DTSC will continue to monitor the land use covenants.
