SITE INVESTIGATION/CLEANUP DOCUMENTS

- DTSC evaluated treatment system effluent sampling results. No hazardous constituents were detected in effluent water. Consequently, DTSC informed Wyle that the effluent water may be discharged into the stream continuously pursuant to the DTSC-approved Operation and Maintenance plan.
- DTSC received a technical memorandum workplan for the in-door air sampling near Wyle's northwestern border (along Golden West Lane) and soil gas sampling near Wyle's western border (high school and along Hillside Avenue).

INVESTIGATION/CLEANUP FIELD WORK

- DTSC project team is planning to continue Wyle inspection in early September to evaluate sampling locations proposed in the draft remedial investigation workplan. DTSC staff will modify sampling locations and/or request additional location/analysis as necessary.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

- DTSC held an open house and a public meeting on August 16, 2004. DTSC updated the community on the status of the investigation and cleanup.
- DTSC sent the Community Advisory Group (CAG) chair copies of the latest site documents including the quarterly groundwater monitoring report.
