Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) Project Status Update for Former Wyle Laboratories Norco Facility Site April 25, 2008

DTSC plans to have an Open House on May 12, 2008 to provide information on draft Removal Action Work Plan (RAW) and receive your comments. The Open House will be held from 5:00 to 9:00pm at Corona-Norco Unified School District, Learning Center North, 2820 Clark Avenue, Norco 92860.

During DTSC's remedial investigation, several small, localized areas with impacted soil were documented. To address the soil contamination, the draft RAW was required. The RAW proposes to excavate contaminated soil from three small areas: 1) lead-impacted soil from Area J14; 2) polychlorinated bi-phenyls (PCB) impacted soil from Area J11; and, 3) perchlorate-impacted soil from Area J11. The total amount of excavated soil is estimated at 105 cubic yards. The proposed soil excavation will be completed in less than 10 days. Confirmation sampling will be conducted after excavation to ensure the contamination is removed and remedial goals are achieved.

This RAW is not the final remedy for the site. Groundwater contamination is currently being investigated. A cleanup plan to address impacted groundwater will be available in the future.
