**FIELD WORK BEGINNING JANUARY 28, 2013**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will oversee maintenance activities of the temporary cap located on Lot 3 of the Zeneca property. The temporary cap is comprised of HydroSeal II, a natural, biodegradable cellulose mix that is mixed with water, and sprayed on the ground surface. The purpose of the HydroSeal II is to form a physical barrier that acts as a ground cover to limit dust generation and exposure to the ground surface.

### WHAT WORK WILL BE DONE?

Glyphosate (post-emergent) will be applied directly to all vegetation on the temporary cap and nearby pampas grass. Later Telar XP (an herbicide) will be applied to the temporary cap to inhibit the growth of vegetation. This application will be conducted as specified in the approved December 2010 Modified Weed Control Plan and will occur prior to the repair of the temporary cap. The temporary cap will be repaired using KUMA's HydroSeal II. Workers will be reapplying the HydroSeal II mixture to areas of the cap where damage or significant weathering is observed.

**Work is expected to begin on January 28, 2013 (weather permitting) and continue through February 4, 2013 weather permitting.** Should the weather present a problem to applying the herbicide or HydroSeal II field work maybe extended until February 11, 2013. All work will be completed during normal business hours (8:00 AM to 5:00), Monday through Friday. Residents should expect to see:

- Trucks with herbicide and HydroSeal II
- Workers in protective gear
