The California Environmental Protection Agency, Regional Water Quality Control Board and the Department of Toxic Substances Control will be conducting an workshop to provide information and answer questions on the Remedial Investigation (RI) and Human Health Risk Assessment (HRA) for the Humboldt Road Burn Dump (HRBD). The HRBD is located between Humboldt Road and Highway 32 in Chico, California. The RI report and the HRA were prepared by consultants for the City of Chico and they are intended to present the type and extent of hazardous substances releases along with assessment of potential human health risks associated with exposure to those contaminants.

The Public Workshop will be held Wednesday, March 27, 2002 at 7:00 p.m. in Conference Room of the Chico City Council Chambers. The city council chambers are located at 421 Main Street in Chico, California. All interested persons are encouraged to attend this informational meeting.
