**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: June 6, 2011 through July 6, 2011**

**WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?** The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) invites you to comment on a Corrective Measures Proposal (CMP) for the 9.7 acre Calwest Galvanizing Facility (Facility). The primary objective of the CMP is to present a final remedy that will complete corrective action at the Facility. The Facility was developed as a galvanizing plant in 1961 and continues to operate today. On October 1, 2009, Valmont Industries, Inc; Valmont Coatings, Inc; and James A. Wyatt, as Trustee of the Wyatt Family Trust entered into a legally binding agreement with DTSC to investigate heavy metal contamination located at the Facility. The proposed corrective measures consists of recording a Land Use Covenant (LUC) to ensure that Facility soil would be classified as a hazardous substance and properly managed, and a restriction on drilling for drinking water will be included. The LUC will limit future owners and operators to only commercial/industrial land uses.

As required by California Law, DTSC has performed a review of the proposed corrective measure in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based on the review, DTSC has determined that the CMP will not have any significant adverse effects on public health or the environment, and proposes to issue a CEQA Notice of Exemption (NOE) in connection with this project. The proposed CEQA NOE is available for public review during the 30-day comment period.

DTSC encourages you to review and provide comments on the CMP during the Public Comment Period running from **June 6, 2011 – July 6, 2011**. DTSC will consider all comments before finalizing its decision to approve the CMP.
