The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has completed the technical review of the RCRA Post-Closure Permit Renewal Application, revised October 16, 2015 (Approved Application), for Chevron U.S.A. Inc., Richmond Refinery located at 841 Chevron Way, Richmond, California.
