DTSC RECEIVES PERMIT RENEWAL APPLICATION FROM SAN ONOFRE NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION

On January 2, 2014, The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received the permit renewal application from Southern California Edison Company (Edison). Edison is requesting authorization from DTSC to continue the storage of hazardous waste. DTSC will evaluate the application to determine if it is complete. DTSC may request additional information from Edison before determining completeness. If the application is determined to be complete, DTSC will then prepare a draft permit for public review and comment.

Edison currently operates three permitted units to store hazardous waste at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station facility. These units store hazardous waste with low and high levels of radioactivity. Edison ships the waste off-site within a year. These units are located on the grounds of the generating station.

If DTSC renews the Permit, DTSC would continue to allow Edison to store hazardous waste during the decommissioning process at the generating station, located along the Old Pacific Highway, next to San Onofre State Beach, three miles south from the City of San Clemente (see map). This permit would be in effect for ten years.
