**YOU MAY REVIEW AND COMMENT ON THE DRAFT PERMIT RENEWAL,
LAWRENCE LIVERMORE NATIONAL LABORATORY SITE 300, near Tracy CA 95377
Public Comment Period beginning: March 28 to May 17, 2016**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) Permitting Division in Berkeley, California invites you to review and submit comments on the draft Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Draft Permit) for Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, P.O. Box 808, L-293, Livermore, CA 94551-0808 (LLNL) for its Site 300 facility (Site 300) off Corral Hollow Road in the eastern Altamont Hills near Tracy, California in San Joaquin County.

DTSC received the permit renewal application for Site 300 on July 1, 2005. On June 18, 2008 DTSC issued a public notice and initiated public comment period for a draft permit (the 2008 Draft Permit). In consideration of comments received on the 2008 Draft Permit and due to soil samples needed prior to the issuance of the 2008 Draft Permit, DTSC did not make a decision on the 2008 Draft Permit, and instead has issued the Draft Permit, which is considered a new draft permit under applicable regulations.

DTSC issues this public notice to start a public comment period on the Draft Permit, which is a modified version of the 2008 Draft Permit. If the Draft Permit is approved, it will allow for the continued treatment and storage of non-nuclear explosive hazardous waste and residue as well as the storage of non-explosive hazardous waste.

In addition to authorizing the storage of on-site generated hazardous waste, the Draft Permit would authorize Site 300 to continue accepting explosive waste from the LLNL Main site located in Livermore for storage and treatment at Site 300. Radioactive, low level radioactive, or mixed waste are not approved to be stored or treated under this Draft Permit.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE? DTSC's Office of Permitting – Berkeley (address below) is processing the permit application. You may submit comments in writing during the public comment period, which begins **March 28, 2016 and ends May 17, 2016**. Written comments must be postmarked or emailed by May 17, 2016 and sent to: Alejandro Galdamez, Project Manager, DTSC Office of Permitting, 700 Heinz Avenue, Suite 300, Berkeley, California 94710 or via electronic mail at Alejandro.Galdamez@dtsc.ca.gov.

DTSC will hold a Public Hearing, where any person may submit oral or written comments and data concerning the Draft Permit, on: Wednesday, April 27, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at Monticello Elementary School, Multipurpose Room located at 1001 Cambridge Place, Tracy, CA. 95377, (209) 833-9300.

After the public comment period concludes, DTSC will consider all comments prior to making a final permit decision and issue a response to comments document, which will be made available to

commenters and other members of the public. DTSC will also notify the applicant and each person who has submitted comments or requested notice of the final Permit decision. This notice will reference the procedures for appealing a decision on the Permit.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): Under the California Environmental Quality Act, DTSC must evaluate whether the proposed actions may have significant adverse impacts on human health and the environment. DTSC prepared a Environmental Document Analysis. Based on this analysis, DTSC found that the previously issued Negative Declarations from 1996 and 1997 are appropriate for the project. If the permit is approved, DTSC will file a Notice of Determination with the Governor's Office of Planning and Research State Clearinghouse.
